

The Millennium

- Development of the SEED aspect of the Abrahamic Covenant
- Genesis 3:15 (NKJV) *And I will put enmity Between you and the woman, And between your seed and her Seed; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel.”*
- Genesis 35:11 (NKJV) *Also God said to him: “I am God Almighty. Be fruitful and multiply; a nation and a company of nations shall proceed from you, and kings shall come from your body.*

The Millennium

- Genesis 49:8-10 (NKJV) “**Judah**, you are he whom your brothers shall praise; Your hand shall be on the neck of your enemies; **Your father’s children shall bow down before you.** **Judah is a lion’s whelp;** From the prey, my son, you have gone up. He bows down, he lies down as a lion; And as a lion, who shall rouse him? **The scepter shall not depart from Judah**, Nor a lawgiver from between his feet, Until Shiloh comes (OR until he comes to whom it belongs); And to Him shall be the obedience of the people.

- Fulfillment Of The Covenant
- Isaiah 9:6-7 (NKJV) **For unto us a Child is born, Unto us a Son is given; And the government will be upon His shoulder.** And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. **Of the increase of His government and peace There will be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever.** The zeal of the Lord of hosts will perform this.

The Millennium

- Matthew 1:1 (NKJV) The book of the genealogy of Jesus Christ, the Son of David, the Son of Abraham:
- Luke 1:26-27 (NKJV) Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name was Mary.
- Luke 1:30-33 (NKJV) Then the angel said to her, “Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name Jesus. He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end.”

The Millennium

- Matthew 4:17 (NKJV) From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, “**Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.**”
- Matthew 21:4-5 (NKJV) All this was done that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying: “Tell the daughter of Zion, ‘**Behold, your King is coming to you, Lowly, and sitting on a donkey, A colt, the foal of a donkey.**’ ”
- Matthew 21:42-44 (NKJV) Jesus said to them, “Have you never read in the Scriptures: ‘The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone. This was the Lord’s doing, And it is marvelous in our eyes’ ? “**Therefore I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken from you and given to a nation bearing the fruits of it.** And whoever falls on this stone will be broken; but on whomever it falls, it will grind him to powder.”

The Millennium

- Matthew 24:29-30 (NKJV) “Immediately after the tribulation of those days the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from heaven, and the powers of the heavens will be shaken. Then the sign of the Son of Man will appear in heaven, and then all the tribes of the earth will mourn, and they will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory.
- Daniel 7:13-14 (NKJV) “I was watching in the night visions, And behold, One like the Son of Man, Coming with the clouds of heaven! He came to the Ancient of Days, And they brought Him near before Him. Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, That all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, Which shall not pass away, And His kingdom the one Which shall not be destroyed.

The Millennium

- **Zechariah 14:4 (NKJV)** And in that day His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, Which faces Jerusalem on the east. And the Mount of Olives shall be split in two, From east to west, Making a very large valley; Half of the mountain shall move toward the north And half of it toward the south.
- **Zechariah 14:9 (NKJV)** And the Lord shall be King over all the earth. In that day it shall be “The Lord is one,” And His name one.

The Millennium

- Matthew 25:31-32 (NKJV) “When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him, then He will sit on the throne of His glory. All the nations will be gathered before Him, and He will separate them one from another, as a shepherd divides his sheep from the goats.
- Revelation 3:20-21 (NKJV) Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me. To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne.
- Matthew 27:11 (NKJV) Now Jesus stood before the governor. And the governor asked Him, saying, “Are You the King of the Jews?” Jesus said to him, “It is as you say.”

The Millennium

- Matthew 27:37 (NKJV) And they put up over His head the accusation written against Him: **THIS IS JESUS THE KING OF THE JEWS.**
- Acts 1:3 (NKJV) to whom He also presented Himself alive after His suffering by many infallible proofs, being seen by them during forty days and **speaking of the things pertaining to the kingdom of God.**
- Acts 1:6 (NKJV) Therefore, when they had come together, they asked Him, saying, “**Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel?**”
- Acts 1:7-8 (NKJV) And He said to them, “**It is not for you to know times or seasons which the Father has put in His own authority.** But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

The Millennium

- Acts 3:12 (NKJV) So when Peter saw it, he responded to the people: “Men of Israel, why do you marvel at this? Or why look so intently at us, as though by our own power or godliness we had made this man walk?”
- Acts 3:17-21 (NKJV) “Yet now, brethren, I know that you did it in ignorance, as did also your rulers. But those things which God foretold by the mouth of all His prophets, that the Christ would suffer, He has thus fulfilled. Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord, and that He may send Jesus Christ, who was preached to you before, whom heaven must receive until the times of restoration of all things, which God has spoken by the mouth of all His holy prophets since the world began.”

The Millennium

- Revelation 5:4-5 (NKJV) So I wept much, because no one was found worthy to open and read the scroll, or to look at it. But one of the elders said to me, “Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals.”
- Revelation 19:16 (NKJV) And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

The Millennium

- Revelation 20:4-6 (NKJV) **And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years. But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection. Blessed and holy is he who has part in the first resurrection. Over such the second death has no power, but they shall be priests of God and of Christ, and shall reign with Him a thousand years.**

- Revelation 20:4-6 (NKJV) **And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. - 2 Timothy 2:12 (NKJV) **If we endure, We shall also reign with Him. If we deny Him, He also will deny us.**

The Millennium

- Revelation 22:16 (NKJV) “I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you these things in the churches. I am the Root and the Offspring of David, the Bright and Morning Star.”
- Genesis 1:26-28 (NKJV) Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.” ... Then God blessed them, and God said to them, “Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.”

The Millennium

- Luke 4:5-7 (NKJV) Then the devil, taking Him up on a high mountain, showed Him all the kingdoms of the world in a moment of time. And the devil said to Him, “All this authority I will give You, and their glory; for this has been delivered to me, and I give it to whomever I wish. Therefore, if You will worship before me, all will be Yours.”
